

SUMMARY OF WTTA RULE & PROCEDURE CHANGES

FALL 2020 SEASON

- 1) There will be NO sub limits or penalties for any flight.
- 2) There will be no defaults. Teams that cannot play a line(s) for any reason will have the option to reschedule or cancel. If line(s) are canceled they will be scored as a double default, no points awarded.
- 3) If a home facility is closed, the home team will immediately notify their opponents. If courts are available at the opponent's facility, the match will be moved there. If not, then the match may be rescheduled or canceled (see #2 above)
- 4) Matches rescheduled for any reason may be played any time until 7 days after the end of the season
- 5) Team points from this season will not count toward future placement of teams.
- 6) All players must submit a signed waiver form to their captain before the start of the season. Roster player waivers should be noted by the captain on the website. Sub waivers should be collected and communicated to your club rep, who will mark the website.
- 7) Players must bring their own towel, water, etc. No spectators at any match.
- 8) Captains must make visitors aware of requirements at their facility. For all public facilities, players are required to wear masks AT ALL TIMES other than when actually playing the match.
- 9) Any player who is diagnosed with or exposed to Covid 19 must immediately contact all players they have had contact with in the prior 14 days, as well as their club rep. Players who have been diagnosed and/or exposed will be expected to quarantine for at least 14 days and avoid any exposure to other players in the league.
